WHAT DOES CARD ENTERPRISES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

WHY?

Financial companies choose how they share your information. Federal law gives members the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

WHAT?

The type of personal information we collect and share depend on the products or services you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and credit score
- When you are no longer a customer of Card Enterprises, we continue to share you information as described in this notice.

HOW?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Card Enterprises chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.
